Plan On Being A Little RECKLESS This August!

You're going to notice some changes starting with August 14. We will be kicking off the new school year with one worship service at 10:30am, followed with a meal from *Jugs Catering*. There will be time to chat, play games, and listen to music together as a congregation.


August 14 is also the kick off for a very important worship series: *Reckless: A Journey Into the Extravagant Heart of God.* No, that's too long to put on a bulletin cover. We'll call it *Reckless*. God's love for us is surprising but what does it mean to call it reckless?

We will spend five weeks on three parables Jesus shared as recorded by Luke in the 15th Chapter of his gospel. Though we often call the final parable of the chapter *The Prodigal Son*, Timothy Keller points out that it makes more sense to talk about our *Prodigal God*. The word prodigal doesn't mean wayward. It means 'recklessly extravagant,' as in spending lavishly. The one who is the most extravagant in the story of the two sons is the Father, who is, of course, a stand in for God.

I originally entitled the series: Why You Are the Way You Are and How To Do Something About It, but again that was too long. The response of the younger son, the older son, and the storyteller are very different from one another. In fact, along with one unmentioned person in the parable, they describe three different ways to find meaning and purpose in life. Almost all of us fall into one category or another. For a short story, the Parable of the Waiting Father has a lot to say and packs a big punch.

We want to make sure our children are included in both traditional and contemporary worship services. We also want to make sure that children from both services have the option of Sunday School. We will continue to offer a children's message in the two traditional services—so nothing will change appreciably for families with children. In contemporary worship, the children will go to Sunday School before worship begins but will be brought back to worship with 15 minutes left. It's our intention to use a variety of kid-friendly options for the closing time of that service such as a children's message, a child-directed application of the morning's theme, or a worship song that the kids can join in with percussion instruments.



3rd Grade Bibles: Each year during September, we begin by having a short class about the Bible for our third graders and their parents. However, some folks are not a part of the Church until their kids are 3rd or 4th graders. If you are in that category, please consider joining us for the Bible class on **September 11 at the 9am** Then we will present the Bibles to the kids during the 10:30am Traditional or 10:45am Contemporary worship.



BUILDING PROJECTS



Have you Noticed the Updates to the CUMC Water Fountains?



There has been a growing number of requests from CUMC staff, preschool teachers, and church members to have the ability to fill their personal water bottles at our water fountains. The request was approved by the Trustees and the Governing Council to retrofit the water fountains in three locations (Door 3, near the gym and second floor classrooms) by adding a bottle filler to the existing water

fountains. This is another example of CUMC going Green by encouraging more refillable bottle usage.



"Going GREEN" Bottled water is 2000x more expensive than tap. Plastic bottle production requires three times the amount of water that it contains! A ticker on the bottle filling station keeps track of the disposable water bottles CUMC is not using!

The Endowment Committee approved the use of the Rushlight Greatest Needs fund to pay for the expense to retrofit the three water fountains, an expense well worth supporting.

The Rushlight Greatest Needs fund is an unrestricted/undesignated account in the

Endowment Fund to be used for areas of significant need. We are thankful for all the families who have provided support to the Endowment Fund and especially God for the blessings and riches He has bestowed upon our church!
